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1. SUMMARY:

Environmental Concerns was contracted by Eric Patel. The Comfort Inn.

To provide a Phase 1 Environmental Site Assessment for a property located at, 337 Devereaux, Natchez Ms, 39120. Environmental Concerns, (EC), visited the target property on September 27 2008 and completed a physical, visual reconnaissance of the site, and surrounding area within the designated target property. The results of the site visit and research of available State and Federal Data are incorporated in this final report for the Phase 1 Assessment. The final report includes Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations

2. INTRODUCTION:

Environmental Concerns conducted a review of regulatory search information; the radii equaled or exceeded the criteria specified in ASTM E 1527-05. A regulatory record search of this nature is based on information published by State and Federal regulatory agencies, and is used to evaluate if the subject property or nearby off-site properties are listed as having a past or present record or potential environmental impact. Please note the regulatory listings include only those facilities that are known to regulatory agencies at the time of publication. The regulatory search data report by, EDR Inc dated September 23 2008, Inquiry # 2324689.3 is presented herein. See attached data for results of environmental impact statements, and locations of adjoining sites that may or may not affect the subject site. See Executive Summary.

The Site Evaluation was performed using the guidelines under ASTM Standard Practice E 1527-05, E 1528 for Environmental Site Assessments Standards and Practices to develop and evaluation of environmental risks associated with a parcel of real estate.

The standard scope of work for this project included (1) Site Reconnaissance of the property (2) Review of the surrounding land use to assess the potential for off-site environmental contamination; (3) Records Review of Federal, State and County data, Radius maps, and Geological data (4) Interviews concerning various environmental issues with purchaser and local Government. (5) Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations. (6) The goal of the Environmental Site Assessment Phase One, of a parcel of land is to identify recognized environmental conditions. Recognized Environmental Conditions, means the presence or Likely presence of any hazardous substances or petroleum products on a property under conditions that indicate an existing release, as past release, or a material threat of any substances or petroleum products into structures on the property or into the ground, ground water or surface water of the property

3. Purpose

The purpose of this investigation was to assess the general environmental conditions of the surrounding area, including the subject property, and provide documentation of any incidents that may have a negative impact on the site.

4. Special Terms and Conditions

There were no special terms or conditions requested by the Client. Issues and conditions outside the standard scope for this report are as follows. Wetlands Research: Sub-Surface Sampling: Sampling of Water or Soils:

5. Limitations and Exceptions

There were no limitations or exceptions (deletions) requested by the property owner or tenant that changed the standard scope of work performed.

6. Limiting: Conditions

Access to the subject property was not restricted. There were no established or requested limiting conditions.

7. SITE BACKGROUND:

Motel, surrounded by small commercial services, see attached Business Directory Abstract for listing. See attached Certified Sanborn Maps. This information has not been verified in this report. Observations were made from historical maps, and visual observations.

8. Site Location

9. Site; Vicinity Characteristic.

The subject site is rural, surrounded by Commercial Services and Single Family Homes.

10. Structures, and Roads, and Other Improvement

The Target site is a public Motel facility built in approximately 1994. The Comfort Inn Motel. There is a swimming pool on site with an adjoining building that is the resident manager private residence. The private residence was not inspected in this report. The subject property is located adjacent to well established paved roads. City sewer system, and curbing for storm water runoff and Public utilities. Asphalt paved at the rear of the building, and one side.

11. Prior, Site Evaluations or Liens

There is no indication of any property or environmental liens against the subject property, as of this report. There are no historical or registered wetlands or wildlife habitats on the subject property. There is no history of an environmental site assessment at the target site within the past two years.

12. Past and Current Uses of the Subject Property.

Motel. The Comfort Inn.

14. Past and Current Uses of Adjoining Property

The adjoining properties on the perimeters are small commercial services, single family houses.

15. Hazardous Materials users and Hazardous Waste Generators.

There may be multiple listing of data for sites with registered underground fuel storage tanks (USTs,) and users of hazardous materials, or generators of hazardous waste. Inclusion on these lists does not mean that environmental contamination has occurred at the sites: rather, it indicates that the site operations include use of or production of regulated chemicals.

16. Site, Observations and Interviews.

On September 27 2008, a site assessment was conducted, by Environmental Concerns; Representated by, Don Fling; Site Assessor, Inspector. Don visually inspected the subject site with accompaniment of Eric Patel the owner, manager. The building was inspected in all accessible common areas. Telephone conservations and Internet data records were checked with the County, Tax Assessor. Adjoining sites were observed visually from the street. Phone conservations were made to County Water District, and, City Fire Department. State and Federal Data records research was conducted from data provided by (EDR). Environmental Data Resources, Project # 2324689.3. Historical Fire Insurance Maps were reviewed. Natchez City Business Directories for historical and current business was reviewed. Historical Aerial Photographs were analyzed. Current Photos of the target site and adjoining sites were taken and reviewed.

17. Findings Conclusions, Recommendations: A. Findings, B. Conclusions, C. Recommendations.

Environmental Concerns has performed a Phase 1 ESA in conformance with the scope and limitations of ASTM Practice E 1527, and E 1528 for 337 Devereaux Dr. Natchez Ms, 39120. Any exceptions to, or deletions from, this practice are described in section" Deviations, of this report. Based on the results of our review of an environmental and regulatory database search, review of regulatory agency records, and site reconnaissance, our Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations of this assessment are as follows:

17A.Findings:

The target property was not listed in any of the databases searched for environmental concerns. No mapped sites were found in the searched data of available ('reasonably ascertainable") government records either on the target property or within the search radius around the target property for databases outlined. (Executive Summary). There were sites listed in State and Federal Records Database (EDR) Executive Summary page and summarized that may or may not have an environmental impact on the Target Site. Due to inadequate information, and data availablabilty, Environmental Concerns was not able to make a professional judgment on all adjoining sites.

There is no indication of any property or environmental liens against the subject property, as of this report. There are no historical or current wetlands or wildlife habitats, pits ponds or lagoons on the subject property There were no identifiable Emitting foul odors from sewers during the site reconnaissance.

There was no identifiable petroleum, chemical spills, or surface staining on the ground surface during the site visit, inspection. Waste water and storm drainage flows away from the target site.

There is no history of leaking Underground Fuel Storage Tanks on this site.

There did not appear to be any staining or chemical drums at the target site or adjoining properties at the time of the inspection.

17. B.Conclusions:

There were no current identifiable environmental concerns that would impact the site or surrounding area. This assessment has revealed no evidence of recognized environmental conditions with this property, no further inquiry is necessary at this time.

17. C.Recommendations:

No further environmental assessment is considered necessary at this time. September 30 2008.


